

Round 14 Preview - Football



The fifth placed on the ladder Poowong face a test that will paint supporters a much clearer picture of what the season holds when it meets the fourth placed Neerim Neerim South and a team that has a habit of crushing teams that do not measure up. It shapes as a season defining match for the Magpies. Win and it will surely make the finals but a loss will keep the door ajar for most likely Lang Lang. The SEN 91.9fm broadcast team will set up shop at Nilma Darnum this Saturday where the Bombers will play host to Lang Lang and a team that looks like it is starting to gel under new coach Daniel Fry, who guided Longwarry to flag glory in 2019.

POOWONG v NEERIM NEERIM SOUTH

Credit to new Magpie coach Rod Gundrill for his charges continue to perform better than the sum of their parts. Poowong is eight points clear of sixth on the ladder so a finals spot is theirs to lose. This week presents a big test about how much the Maggies have improved after they copped a 102-point belting at Neerim South in round 3. Jack Hazendonk, Mitch Van't Hoff and Matt Cozzio look inspired choices as team leaders who have all led by example. Neerim South dined out on Nyora last week and it sure knows how to smash a side. Captain Kody Wilson has been inspirational, snagged 5 goals last week and there would not have been a player to exert more influence on games since round 6 when he resumed after a late start to the season. The home side will also need to keep prolific goal kickers Luke Kinder and Lachlan Bambridge quiet if it hopes to produce an upset.

NILMA DARNUM v LANG LANG

Bomber coach Paul Alger can best hope his players don't drop their bundle. While yet to win a match it has improved this season but over the last month it is showing signs of weariness. It is a given that the experienced quartet of Oxley Huson, Nick Carrigy, Nat Campbell and Jeremy Jarred will make things difficult for the Tigers but like many a bottom team others must step up if it can produce a boil over. Lang Lang is still a chance to make the top five. New recruits Kalin Parker, Mitch Davey, Dylan Gallasch, Daniel Reid, Riley Dolan and Chaise Jordan now look like they are building cohesion after many indifferent team performances.

CATANI v TRAFALGAR

After a good month between rounds 8 and 11, when it proved very competitive. Catani now appears to have tapered off after sizeable losses to Ellinbank and Longwarry. Cannot knock the consistency of all the Williams boys, Dylan, James and Brett but it lacks the quality line breakers to hurt opposition clubs. The Bloods are nothing if not consistent working its way up to third on the table as it has not tripped up against any team below fourth. While it only kicked 12 goals last week it had nine goalkickers which illustrates it does not rely heavily on any one player. Coach Tom Hallinan told this scribe at the start of the season that despite the loss of a lot of experience it would improve by the week and be competitive and so far, their efforts have justified his comments.

BULN BULN v LONGWARRY

In all fairness the Lyrebirds were desperately unlucky to suffer their first loss of the season on a muddy ground at Ellinbank last week. It led at every change and until the last 30 seconds. Expect it to rebound hard as all good teams do. Two weeks ago, Longwarry looked like it had thrown in the towel but since the return of Russell Lehman and two wins in a row it now has a glimmer of hope it can make the top five. Not all gloom and doom for the Crows, for if it doesn't make finals, it can seek solace in the encouraging output from youngsters Cooper Brown, Liam Kirkman, Harry Colvin and Fintan Fox.

NYORA v ELLINBANK

The Saints are in a form slump. It has gone from a top five prospect in round 8 when it had three victories to a team that now will struggle to match the six wins it secured in 2022. There is no knock on the Eagles this season. It again reinforced it is the best team in heavy going when it upset flag favourites Buln Buln after emerging 20-year-old Gaige White kicked the winning goal in the dving seconds last week. Coach Jake Harper and Captain Mick Urie have their side ticking along nicely.

- If you are struggling to send trainers to the make up games, contact the home ground club for assistance (in the past they have been able to help)
- If needed game times can be changed to accommodate for U16 players who also play at U18 level
- First name team as the 'home team' is responsible for inputting results into Play HQ
- First name team must also wear home shorts and supply the football at a neutral venue


