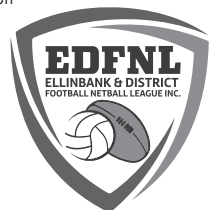

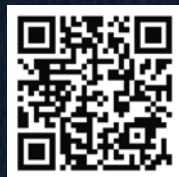

Round 20 Preview - Football

This Saturday heralds the 20th and final round of the Parklea home and away season. Still, plenty of interest. While Buln Buln is the minor premier all ladder positions between second and sixth could change. Its boom or bust for the 6th placed Lang Lang who must win and win well at Ellinbank to displace Poowong from its current 5th spot on the ladder which would entitle it to an elimination final appearance on its home ground next Sunday.

ELLINBANK v LANG LANG

Both must win. The home side to consolidate second on the ladder and the visitors to give themselves a chance to sneak back into the top five. Ellinbank lost at Trafalgar last week but held its own for most of the match. It was buoyed by the return of former coach Ben Wragg and fellow veteran Adam Cook. Lang Lang did beat Ellinbank when they met in round nine. Last Saturday it pushed Neerim South for three quarters thanks to plenty of resilience from Brad Harding, Josh Brown, Kade Finlay Smith, Daniel Reid and Dylan Gallasch before the Cats drew clear. At home the Eagles are hard to topple and should book a qualifying final berth but it will be real fight.

LONGWARRY v TRAFALGAR

The Crows disappointed this season. It has lost four of its last five matches to fall out of final calculations – not that it ever looked good enough to justify a finals position. Captain and utility Darren Granger has been a standout as has U18 midfielder Cooper Brown and Jedd Serong (42 goals). The athleticism and marking ability of Trafalgar ruckman Dylan Farrell has been a constant thorn in many an opponent all season. The Bloods sure like a scrap and have a good record in close encounters winning six games by 16 points or less. It can an ill afford to lose and this motivation will be enough to get the vital four points on offer to guarantee it a double-chance.

NEERIM NEERIM SOUTH v YARRAGON

Neerim Neerim South is a top side. Desperately unlucky to be in fourth position. Interestingly though its percentage this season at 243 is 107 less than the outrageous 350% it finished last years home and away season. Such is its firepower it boasts four of the top ten on the goal kicking table – Luke Kinder (51), Lachlan Bambridge (42) and Ton Crole and Chris Urie both with 30 majors. Conversely Yarragon's top goal kickers this season read Mitch Jolley

(17), Travis Davis and Liam Smith-Butterworth both 11. Zac Hogton, Ryan Devine, Rob Hermann, Sam Van Der Zalm, Harrison Perry and Taylor Rainey have caught the eye regularly, but the Panthers lack depth hence only four victories in 2023.

POOWONG v NILMA DARNUM

Poowong sit in 5th position and will be out to build on their 3% advantage on Lang Lang – should the Tigers pull off victory at Ellinbank. A win should see the Magpies play in the elimination final next week. The class of on ballers Jack Hazendonk, Steven McInness, ruck Conor Cunningham, Alex Henshall (24 goals) and defender Mitch Vant' Hof will see the home side far to good. Credit to Nilma Darnum for it has improved in 2023 but still did not achieve a much-yearned win. Must admire the attitude of Sage Tapner, Oxley Huson, Seb Crowle, Nick Carrigy and Nat Campbell, who give it their all week in – week out against the odds.

NYORA v CATANI

Both teams will be frustrated they did not win more games this season. Both improved markedly in many areas which was indicated by their improved percentages but it has not been demonstrated in higher positions on the ladder. For Nyora that relied so heavily on Dylan Heylen and Travis Stewart in 2022 it spread the workload more in 2023 with Jordan Anderson, Connor Thompson, Nick Anderson and Max Mattock all making their presence felt. Similar with Catani, newcomers Tyson Robinson and Matt Soutar-Smith were prominent and lent good support to regulars Cody Banbury, Brett and James Williams, Tom Keily and Michael Ralph. This is a 50/50 game. The team that wants it the most will win. On the basis Catani was plucky against Buln Buln last week I'll tip it to chalk up its fifth victory and displace the Saints in eighth position.
