The stakes could not be any higher this Saturday for all participating teams – a spot in the 2023 Parklea grand final for the winners and it is the end of the road for the losers. In the seniors Ellinbank face a task that will not be easy; a preliminary final clash with the inform Neerim South who are on a mission to achieve back-to-back premierships. ELLINBANK v NEERIM SOUTH

Round 5 – Ellinbank 8.5.35 defeated Neerim South 5.10.40

Round 17 – Neerim South 12.18.90 defeated Ellinbank 8.8.56

The head-to-head record reads one - all but a factor to weigh heavily will be the composition of the respective line ups. Both will have absentees, but Ellinbank will field a far more depleted team.

The Cats will miss Tom Crole (ankle) and Chris Urie (quad) while there will be a mid-week watch on Lachlan Guy who hobbled off the ground last Sunday with what looked like an ankle injury. The Eagles will definitely miss Coach Jake Harper and utility Tom Johnson while there must be a doubt on Mick Urie, Tim Mashado and Keegan Bott who missed last week while Adam Cook and Ryan Atherton left the field last Saturday.

Irrespective who plays uppermost in the Eagles minds will be how to nullify the red-hot Cat forwards and midfield. Sharpshooters Lachlan Bambridge, Isaac Fuller, Tyssen Morrow and Luke Kinder will test the depth of the Ellinbank defence and the ball winning ability of Kody Wilson, Nathan Bayne, Ayden Ramm, Lachlan Guy and Jack Blakey will

give the forwards plenty of feed. The Eagles will rely heavily on emerging stars Bryce Joyce and Rylan Smith to provide rebound along with league leading goal kicker Shaun Phelan to escape his minders. Former coach Ben Wragg is also a vital cog as he can hold down a number of key posts. Ellinbank's defence is very good but it's on ballers and forwards appear inferior. Neerim South to win and set up a blockbuster grand final clash with Buln Buln.

Preliminary final day will start with the U16 clash between Neerim South and Lang Lang. The Cats and the minor premiers were upset by Ellinbank last week and are expected to bounce back. For Neerim, Kai & Ash Mounsey, Max Williams and Keegan Friedlander will be prominent and for Lang Lang expect Diesel Bonaddio, Jack Stocks, Robi Nooy and Jarrad Francome are sure to feature prominently.

In the U18s Buln Buln match up against Ellinbank in what should be a tight affair. Among those to keep an eye on are Rylan Kovacs, Will Battley and Ryan Bradshaw for the Lyrebirds and Jack Champion, Rick Rosser and Luke Carbon for the Eagles.

In the reserves Lang Lang, who have come through from the elimination final will meet Buln Buln. For the Lyrebirds Simon Dawson, Bryce Monahan, Fynn Hammond and Jacob Pickthall have been their mainstays this season, but the Tigers chances must still be good because it boasts a strong forward line led by Liam Hetherington (38 goals), Jesse Hand (32) & Geordie Wells (24).

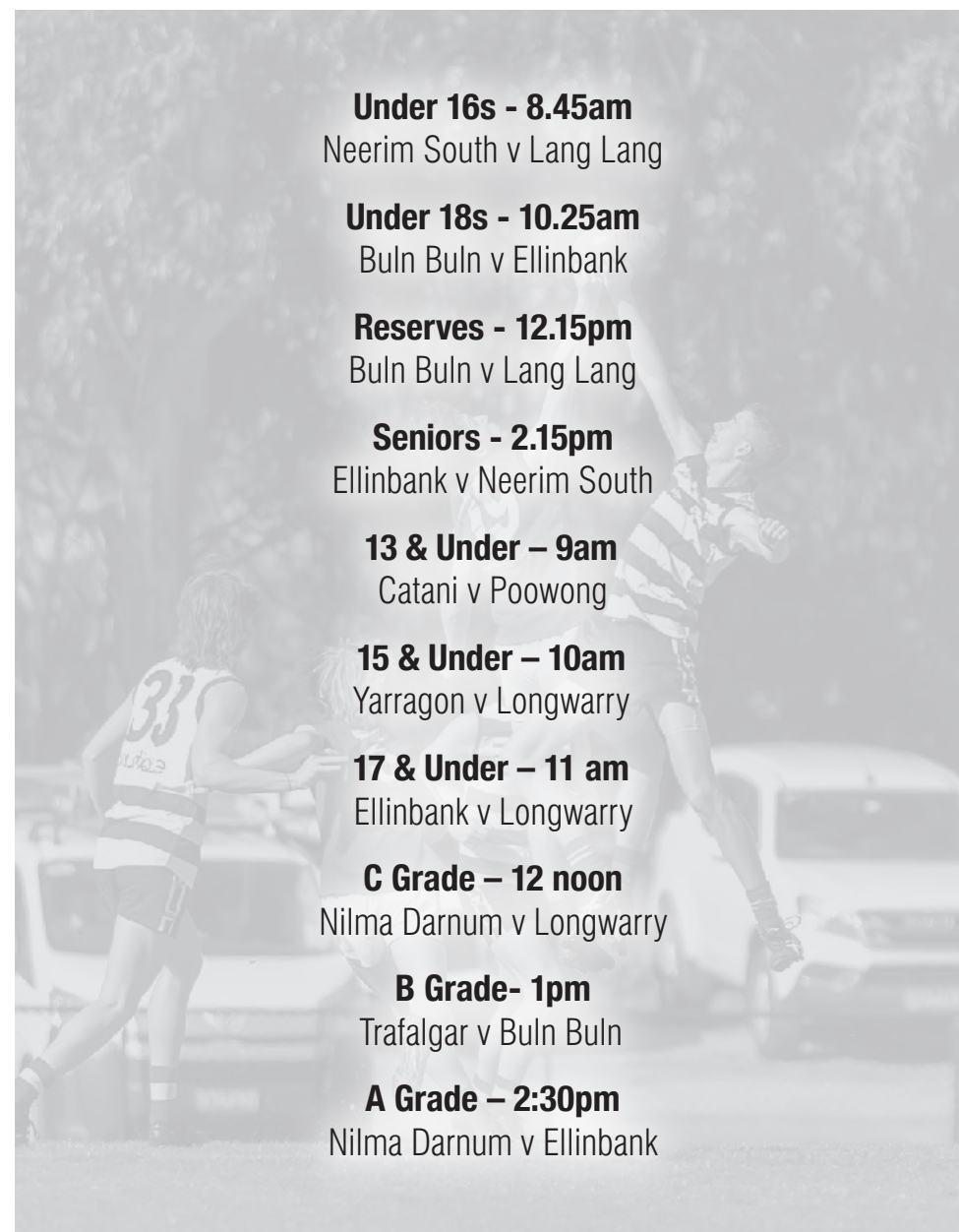

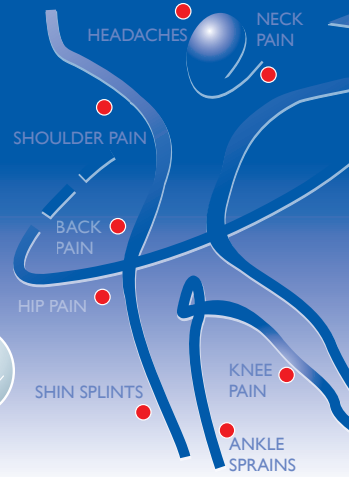
