

# Round 13 Preview - Football

Is Ellinbank, currently 2nd on the ladder genuine premiership material? This Saturday will shed more light on this question when it hosts undefeated leaders Buln Buln. The Lyrebirds sent a powerful message to all rivals last week that there is no ifs and buts about it – it is the clear flag favourites after it torched 2022 premiers Neerim South by 68 points. A kick by kick coverage of the match can be heard if you tune in to SEN Track 91.9fm.

Another interesting if not the most important match this week is Lang Lang's clash against Yarragon - for the loser can kiss goodbye to a top five finish.

### **ELLINBANK v BULN BULN**

The Eagles will enjoy the chance to test themselves against the Lyrebirds. It has regularly out toughed teams around the stoppages and this strength will pose a real threat to Buln Buln. Ellinbank will be pleased key forward Adam Cook returned for his first match of the season last Saturday while it must also be happy that Will Jolley, a star at junior level with the Bankers has returned to the club after a number of years at both the Warragul Guls and Dusties to add to their depth. No knock on the home side and expect it to be well in the contest until the last quarter of the game, Buln Buln loaded up last Saturday with Coach Bob McCallum, Nathan Tutton and Jake Herbel who were all missed matches over the last month and their presence reinforced they are the team to beat.

### LANG LANG v YARRAGON

Fair to say both teams and who occupy 6th and 7th on the ladder have a major question mark on their credibility as a genuine top five prospect. For the entire season form wise the Tigers and the Panthers have been just tepid rather than warm. Lang Lang's loss to Trafalgar before the bye last Saturday was a real kick in the outs for its final's chances. Yarragon has problems offensively and has to graft hard to kick goals illustrated by the fact it has only averaged 51 points per match. Mind you the Tigers are not much better at 53 points per match. Yarragon was fortuitous to get a draw in the round 9 abandoned match and those two points may be handy if it can find form in the second half of the season. It showed signs last week against Trafalgar but that largely off the boot of former StKilda AFL pocket rocket Stephen Milne who kicked 5 goals, but it was a one match appearance. Only one player, Mitchell Jolly (12) has kicked more than 10 goals for Yarragon this season. Home ground advantage sways the result the way of Lang Lang.

### **TRAFALGAR v NILMA DARNUM**

The Bloods have quietly snuck up to third on the ladder. The quality and experience of Curtis Barker and Matt Swenson who kicked two late goals along with some resolute defending by 19-year-old Hardy Kenny saw Trafalgar home in a thriller at Yarragon in round 12. Coach Tom Hallinan was pleased

after the game that he has been able to field the same side in consecutive weeks and another victory looms large this week. The Bombers were eye-ing their first win for the season when it led at half time against Longwarry but it ran out of legs in the second half. The usual suspects Sage Tapner, Oxley Huson, Jeremy Jarred and Nick Carrigy all excelled but once again the Darno's were stretched for depth. Things do not get any easier this week for mercurial veteran Luke James who bagged 5 goals also in a one-off show will not be available.

### LONGWARRY v CATANI

The Crows broke a seven-match losing streak with a strong second half at Nilma Darnum last week. Midfield extractor Russell Lehman returned for his first match since round five and invigorated the midfield and forward line and oh how captain Darren Granger would have enjoyed his presence. Catani has improved vastly this season represented by its percentage that has risen from 28 in 2022 to over 70 this year but last week it produced its worst four quarter effort since the opening round and that too was against Ellinbank. The Blues have plenty of blokes with ticker but simply lacks class. It would have been pleased though that captain Dylan Williams returned for his first match since the fourth round. Who wins? This looks like a line-ball call. Think the home side with Brayden McHugh and Jed Serong will have the superior firepower to secure the match points.

### **NEERIM NEERIM SOUTH v NYORA**

The Neerim South blockbuster against Buln Buln last Saturday turned into a damp squib with the Cats uncharacteristically uncompetitive. This does not bode well for Nyora who is likely to incur their wrath and who beat them by 99 points last time they met. While four premiership players Tyssen Morrow, Alex Johnson, Brock Dorling and Ash Lockett were missing last week one thinks the Cats have hit a flat spot over the last fortnight for it struggled to brush off Catani the previous week. Nyora looked on the way up with three consecutive wins between round six and eight but since then its form has just been so-so. Ruckman Travis Stewart continues to impress with some spectacular marks and many fans may not realise he is only 22 years of age and has only played 30 senior matches as of last week.






