YARRAGON v LANG LANG

This is the SEN91.9FM broadcast match of the day. The Panthers did little to enthuse fans in the first half of the opening round but then fought the game out strongly in the second half against Trafalgar when it looked like it might be in for a hiding. Another newcomer Ayden Ramm, the leagues U18 captain last year did not look out of place at senior level in week one. The Cats to win with plenty in reserve.

NILMA DARNUM v TRAFALGAR

The Bombers will enter unfancied against the Bloods but their opening round effort put a smile on many of its fans and insiders when it was competitive for three guarters at Longwarry. It gave every indication it is vastly improved team. Nat Campbell was outstanding as ever and given a real hand in and around the middle from Sage Tapner, who played at Yarragon in 2022. Blake Cann and Travis Dyke, who both returned over summer were busy. Trafalgar despite the loss of half a dozen quality players was never in any danger in its first round clash against Yarragon but would not be happy conceding many second half goals in a low scoring game. Mature Cranbourne recruit Curtis Barker showed plenty of footy smarts, goal sneak Matt Devon looks like a player on the rise and midfielder Blake Radford displayed the consistency that saw him come runner up in the senior club best & fairest last year. The Darno's will be plucky but the visitors should win with a few goals to spare.






This week's question?


