FOOTBALL SEASON PREVIEW



THE anticipation builds towards round one of the Ellinbank District football season, with the leading teams from 2023 set to be challenged by a group of clubs who have recruited well.

Lang Lang and Longwarry are among the mid-tier teams from 2023 looking to build towards finals.

The Crows will rely on several returning players in their push, while the Tigers have landed arguably the recruit of the off-season in former Cranbourne spearhead and decorated goal scorer Marc Holt.

Buln Buln 2023 finish – Premiers 2024 coach – Bob McCallum

Buln Buln maintain a steady list with skillful forward Cam McPhan a notable return.

Talent from emerging under 18 players is also creating enthusiasm around the club, as the Lyrebirds look to go back-to-back.

After much consideration, Matt Gray will play on as a largely unchanged list chases back to back glory.

Neerim-Neerim South 2023 finish – Runner up 2024 coach – Brent Mounsey

There is also little change for fellow 2023 grand finalists Neerim-Neerim South, who are hoping for another strong season.

Key forwards Lachlan Bambridge to Warragul Industrials and Thomas Crole to Warragul are key departures, but the Cats do get back former under 18 league leading goal kicker Matt Roberts.

Josh White also comes back from injury.

Ellinbank 2023 finish – Preliminary final (3rd) 2024 coach – Jake Harper

Ellinbank will see some changes to their side following some retirements, Adam Cook the most notable of those. Zac Holton also departs to play on the Mornington Peninsula with Will Jolley also set to depart, however the Eagles have recruited well and will hope to challenge again.

The recruits are headlined by former Narre Warren ruckman Connor Wilkins and Makalo Haywood from Hampton Park, while Jamie Ferguson and Rhys Salter are among the players to cross from Drouin.

Jake Harper continues to coach, assisted by Duncan Ireland on the bench.

Trafalgar 2023 finish – Semi finalist (4th) 2024 coach – Tom Hallinan

Trafalgar enter the season hoping to win a final after qualifying but missing out on that elusive finals win the past two seasons.

The Bloods have bolstered the defence with the addition of Belconnen premiership centre-half-back and league team of the year player Brad Hoffmann.

Darcy Brock and Nelson Minichiello return to the club with Blake Radford and Mitch Virtue departing.

Club president Brett Tonkin said the club was pleased with ball movement during pre-season hit outs against Morwell East and Lindenow.

"We're happy with how we're going, we will just have to see where everyone else is," he said.

Shane Baker adds an experienced head to assist Hallinan on the bench, having most recently served as president at Cranbourne.

Poowong 2023 finish – Elimination final (5th) 2024 coach – Dale Carroll

New coach Dale Carroll is the main change at Poowong, with the Magpies to continue to look for improvement from its younger players.

Tom and Will Robertson depart, with no major ins to report. The club's practice match against Carroll's former club Ashwood saw the Magpies show positive signs, although there are some concerns around depth.

Lang Lang 2023 finish – 6th 2024 coach – Daniel Fry

Lang Lang will look to push for finals, having added some handy additions.

Former Cranbourne spearhead and decorated goal kicker Marc Holt will add firepower, while Dylan Wilson returns following a stint at Tooradin-Dalmore.

Football operations manager Scott Fairburn said Daniel Fry was re-committed and coaching well.

Other notable inclusions to the squad are Brad Clarke, Zach Williamson and Norman Barry.

Nyora 2023 finish – 7th 2024 coach – Dylan Heylen

Dylan Heylen will continue to coach the Saints but will be at the helm of a new-look team.

Several players have opted to return to their home clubs, the biggest losses coming in the departure of Travis Stewart and Jack Rosenow.

Club president Sam Dixon said the club had recruited well to offset the departures.

He said the club was looking to build its juniors with under 10s and 12 this year, the first time its had two junior teams in more than eight years.

Longwarry 2023 finish - 8th 2024 coach - Darren Grainger

Longwarry is expected to improve as several former players return to the club to drive the Crows towards a return to finals. Last year's assistant Darren Grainger steps up as coach and will have electric forward Jason Wells at his disposal. Premiership captain from 2019 Nathan Fry returns from Cairns with other key returns including Bailey Stephens (Drouin), Kane Taylor (Warragul Industrials) and Cole Cook.

The Crows have also added former Yarragon coach Tom Wyatt.

Yarragon 2023 finish - 9th 2024 coach - Sam Van der Zalm

Sam Van der Zalm takes the helm as the Panthers aim to continue their steady improvement.

Yarragon have reported good pre-season numbers for their senior sides, with several key players from last season re-committing

The Panthers have added former Hallam assistant Dean Kelly, who also has punting experience in the United States. He is expected to play across half back and wing.

The club has also engaged former Brisbane Bears player and well-regarded coach Lachlan Sim to mentor its coaches over pre-season.

Yarragon are still searching for players to bolster its junior grades.

Catani 2023 finish – 10th 2024 coach – Luke Young

Catani have also added to their list as they look for continued improvement under Luke Young.

Captain Dylan Williams is a key departure, returning to play with his home club Foster.

Among the key ins are brothers Brodie and Jordan White, crossing from Devon Meadows and Seaford respectively. Josh Stewart is another addition from Devon Meadows, while Dean Smith joins from Gembrook.

President Grant Williams said the club was pleased to add an under 18s side and standalone junior club this year.

Nilma-Darnum 2023 finish – 11th 2024 coach – Paul Alger

Nilma-Darnum will enter the season hoping to break its winless drought, which stretches back some 38 games. The Bombers showed signs of some improvement in a practice match against Heatherton, where they had some 50 players across seniors and reserves.

President Rob Campbell said the Bombers would also field both under 16s and 18s, a first in a long time.

"We're just hoping we can get that win," he said.

"We're building a good culture with good honest footballers and people."

New recruits and a raft of talented juniors are expected to hit courts across the Ellinbank and District netball league in season 2024.

The top sides have retained their coaches, with the exception of Lang Lang who welcome back Nicole Hadgkiss to the club. Neerim-Neerim South - off the back of two undefeated seasons - are expected to be frontrunners.

But expect last year's finalists Ellinbank, Nilma Darnum, Trafalgar and Lang Lang - all with recruits - to make a step forward as they chase the Cats.

Neerim-Neerim South 2023: Premiers A grade coach: Christie Urie

Ins: Nicole Stringer and Kasey Bayne both return. Outs: Hayley Stringer (Morwell)

Player to watch: A top defender, Christie Urie claimed the 2022 league best and fairest and 2023 runner-up. Her ability to shut down her opponent and read the play for intercepts can turn any game.

Rising star: Under 17s player, Nari Abrahams played off the bench in C grade last year. Displaying constant improvement, she is on track for opportunities to show her skills in the senior teams.

Neerim South has been undefeated for the past two seasons. With strengths across all thirds of the courts, they are the hunted. But, as last year showed, they are up for the challenge.

Coach Christie Urie is working to build new connections, both defensively and in attack, to maintain consistency. She acknowledged their side was different to last year but looking forward to the challenges ahead.

"There's lot of changes, but good ones too," she said, expecting the top five sides from last year to be pushing for finals yet again.

Ellinbank 2023: Runner-up A grade coach: Taylah Wallace

Ins: Jasmine Ferguson, Courtney Stevens-Risol and Shanara Notman all return.

Outs: Regan Joyce (Drouin)

Player to watch: Courtney Stevens-Risol is a high-class defender who will make life tough for all opposition goalers. Having taken out the 2021 league runner-up best and fairest for the Eagles in a COVID-shortened season, Courtney has returned to the club after having baby number three in 2022 and a short stint at Boolarra in 2023.

Rising star: Top age under 17 goaler Chloe Johnstone. Chloe has a full season of A grade under her belt and played a pivotal role in last year's finals. She is proving to be a tall, strong and ever reliable goal attack or goal shooter.

The Eagles had a great season before being outclassed by Neerim in the grand final. With an enviable record of success and some top recruits, it was no surprise Wallace is aiming to take her side to premiership success.

"We want to be fierce and fair competitors in all senior teams again this year," Wallace said. "We also aim to be consistent throughout our season and enjoy representing our club week in, week out."

Nilma Darnum 2023: 3rd

A grade coach: Rachael Chandler

Ins: Melanie Cook (returns from injury), Caitlyn Frecklington and Skve Rees.

Players to watch: Hard to go past last year's league best and fairest Stacey Lawry. This defender has it all, putting pressure over the shot, closing space in the ring and taking intercepts all over the court. Tall goaler Hayley Purcell is also key to this side's success. Her height and hold make life tough for any defender.

Rising stars: Mia Tweddle and Lauren Marx from the under 17s will look to add youth into the A grade squad. Both girls bring great ball skills, speed and talent beyond their years. Nilma Darnum pushed both Neerim South and Ellinbank in their respective finals, falling agonisingly short of victory on both occasions.

With those mentioned above together with Nikki Mirams, Rachael Chandler and Madlyn Borsato, this line will be looking to better last year's effort and make it all the way through to the grand final.

The team is relatively similar, with a strong defensive end, fast midcourt and taller than normal goaling circle.

Trafalgar 2023: 4th

A grade coach: Dani Davies

Ins: Bella Rosato and Cass Wass elevated from B grade, Lauryn King-Church and Grace McRae.

Outs: Lucy Findlay (Newborough), Megan Hancock, Ella McDonald and Tara Potts

Player to watch: Midcourter Grace McRae is a massive recruit. She will bring speed, agility, tenacity and on-court leadership to the side.

Rising star: Defender Tillie Manfield, an under 17s player who played B grade last year. This determined player offers speed and ability to read the play.

There have been significant changes to the Trafalgar side who have lost significant experience but gain the opportunity to field their home grown talent.

As well as Bella Rosato and Cass Wass stepping up from B grade, the side includes 17-year-olds Imogen Smith and Piper Albert who gained a full season of A grade last year.

Trafalgar has maintained a high ladder position since joining the EDFNL, with coach Dani Davies aiming for club success on that final day in September.

Dani expects the top five from last year to be hard to beat but noted "I don't think there will be any easy games."

Lang Lang 2023: 5th

A grade coach: Nicole Hadgkiss

Ins: Nicole Hadgkiss returns after roles at Peninsula Waves, Rosebud and Alexandra. She is one of five new players in the team.

Player to watch: Gabby Dalgleish will continue to be a force this season. Having recently had a taste in defence, Gabby will continue to push herself to try new positions and be the best player she can for the team.

Rising star: Chelsea Gibson will play her first "official" year of seniors. She is a player to watch as she continues to hone in on her skillset.

Lang Lang showed last year they could trouble any opposition

but perhaps lacked consistency at times.

Starting 2024 on a high, the Tigers have five new players in their A grade side, with a new look goaling and defending end.

Coach Nicole Hadgkiss said the side had the perfect balance of maturity and youth, which will hold them in good stead for the home and away fixture as they work to push into finals. She aims to create a culture that allows players to have a voice, while working together to create a skilful and mentally strong team.

Buln Buln 2023: 6th

A grade coach: Cheryl Kos

Ins: Paige Baker returns, Patty McInnes and Jess Fowler elevated from B grade.

Outs: Taylah Thomas, Ellen Croft and Georgia Coleman

Players to watch: Anna Robertson is a key player for this side, with the ability to play goals or midcourt. Building on last year, Anna comes in fitter, more confident and raring to go. Defenders Erin Smethurst and Maddy Mullens have also put in the hard work and will show increased speed and fitness. Rising star: Eyes will be on tall goaler Patty McInnes to see if she can repeat a stellar year in B grade at the A grade level. She is a strong target and is ready to step up.

Disappointed to miss out on finals, Buln Buln coach Cheryl Kos said 2023 showed great improvement but ultimately "we fell short of our expectations".

"This year, the goal is not just make the finals, but be a real threat to the top teams," she said.

Paige Baker, back from baby number three, is a big in for the side. Baker and Jess Fowler will bring versatility. The solid and fast midcourt of Maggie Nooy and Tahlia Peterson will back these new combinations as they grow and develop. 2023: 7th

Outs: Hannah Russell (pregnancy), Cara Moody and Bec Redley (both relocated).

Player to watch: Always reliable, Jess Hammond is instrumental to her side's success on the court.

Having lost a staggering seven games by four goals or less last year, Catani demonstrated it could match it with the top teams but always fell just short.

A two-goal loss to Nilma, three-goal loss to Ellinbank and seven-goal loss to Neerim South are just some examples. Coach Jess Hammond wants her side to show improvement by finishing off games and pushing for a full four quarters.

Rebuilding after some key players departed, she has a focus on developing the club's talented junior player pool. They have also recruited a midcourter from the south east area.

"Everyone loves an underdog and I'd love it if that was us," she said.

Longwarry 2023: 8th

A grade coach: Holly Stephens

Ins: Molly Green, Olivia Jones, Hilary Fox, Kira Wilson and Katelyn Balfour.

Outs: Hayley Mott, Tiarnee Browney and Catherine Hadkiss

Player to watch: Coming off a great season, Georgia Green

is an absolute workhorse in defence with a great ability to create turnovers. Georgia finished third in the club's best and fairest last year despite missing six weeks.

Rising stars: Both Olivia Jones and Kira Wilson are expected to play key roles in the A grade side. Olivia will play her first senior season and, despite her youth, has experience of playing in all three senior grades as well as being involved in the EDNA representative team and state titles with the Latrobe Valley. Kira is a bottom age under 17s player who already has an extended list of personal accolades. Having been part of Gippsland Storm squads for the past four years and gaining selection in the Gippsland

Power under 16 girls side, Kira is a star with ability to win

games and take incredible intercepts.

Yarragon 2023: 9th

A grade coach: Kellie Orgill and Renee Kemp

Ins: Alysha Marcucci, Carly Warren, Courtney McWhinney, Evelyn Armstrong, Karina Marcucci, Monique Kiezenberg and Tarryn Munro.

Players to watch: The Marcucci sisters - Alysha and Karina - will be key to guiding this developing team on the court. Rising star: Having won the 15 and under league best and fairest last year, junior Courtney McWhinney will look to make an impression at A grade level.

Having being dealt some big losses upon entering the EDFNL, Yarragon has closed the gap in recent years. Whilst they only won a handful of games, the margins were less and they lost three games by just six goals - including to Lang Lang, Buln Buln and Catani.

The aim for 2024 is simple, continue to build the team for future success.

Ins: Trewin sisters return after a year of travel.
Outs: Gracie Green (relocated)

The A grade side has not yet been finalised.

However, there is no doubt it will still be a very young team. Poowong is aiming for a year of growth under the guidance of club stalwart Prue Blackwood.

It's been a difficult few years after a decade of success, only winning two games last season.

However, the club reported all juniors stepping up this year show great potential and they look forward to watching their development.

Footy and netball is back and we're excited for another season at the Cattery!


Preseason on the track and court has been going strong, with both footy and netball putting in the hard yards to have another successful season.


